**10.00 – 11.45**

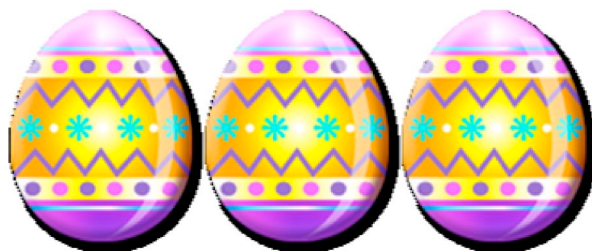

## **Easter Egg Hunt Rules 2010**

**Please take note of these rules and follow the instructions of the PTFA Staff and Teachers on the day. The aim of this event is for the CHILDREN to find the eggs, so we have introduced some new rules for 2010.**

- **Remember your entry tickets you will need them on the day.**
  - **Make sure you bring all of them with you as without them you cannot claim your eggs.**
  - **One ticket lets you claim 1 prize**
  - **If you have found 2 eggs and you only have 1 ticket you cannot claim for the second egg and this will have to be given up to a friend who has not found an egg or returned to the hunt area.**
  - **The more tickets you have the more eggs you can win.**
  - **Every ticket holder will have the chance to win an egg of some description, from a Crème Egg to a Very Large Egg.**
- 1) **At the start of the egg hunt no parents will be allowed to hunt for the eggs until a short time has elapsed, this allows the “children” to find the eggs not you! You will have your chance later, don’t worry.**
  - 2) **Key stage 2 will start first at 10.00am**
  - 3) **Key stage 2 will be advised of your hunt colours**
  - 4) **Key stage 2 will be advised of your hunt zone**
  - 5) **Key stage 1 will start shortly after (avoiding the rush)**
  - 6) **Key stage 1 will be advised of your hunt colours**
  - 7) **Key stage 1 will be advised of your hunt zone**
  - 8) **Parents/Grandparents/Carers will follow shortly after.**
  - 9) **Hunt zones will not be crossed over.**

**Please respect our starting order and let your children hunt for the eggs, there will be clearly defined zones for key stage 1 and 2 and we will NOT mix the eggs in the zones.**

**Miss Ward, Miss Dawe and the PTFA will supervise the key stage 1, 2 hunt areas for the first phase before parents will be allowed to join in.**

**You can only claim eggs in the colours of your key stage, if you have picked up the wrong colour for your Key stage you will not be allowed to claim an egg so listen carefully for your colours at the beginning of the hunt.**

**This event is not designed to make a large sum of money for the school, but it does give the children a great morning out in the fresh air hunting for egg tokens to exchange for Easter eggs big and small. If you can donate an Easter egg it helps us raise greater funds.**
