House points are going up this week.

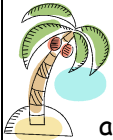

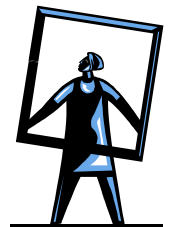
Table tennis
