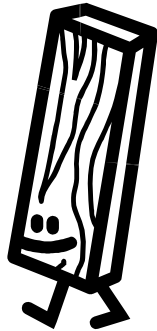

## Joke of the week

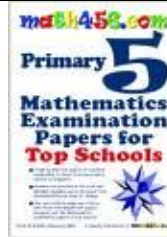
This week's joke is:
