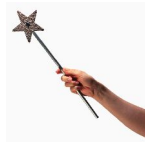

This week's word of the week is **perimeter**. The perimeter of a shape is the total distance around the edges defining the outline of that shape



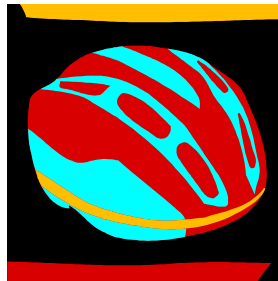
Art



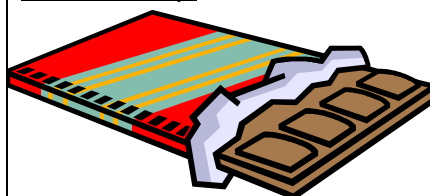
