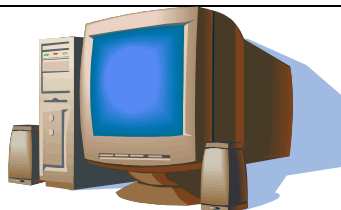

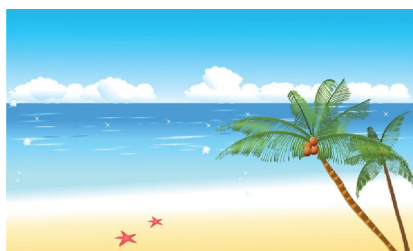
## Moving Memories

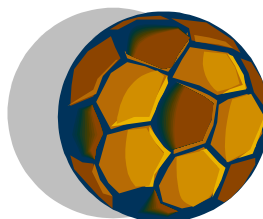
## Camera competition

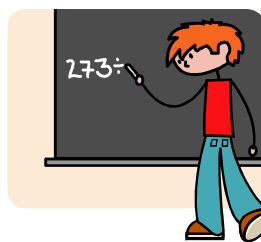
## Herald cup
