

Pupil Voice leaders did a survey about Keep Up Catch Up. Here are their findings:

88.9% of children say they have been to Keep Up Catch Up and of those children 75.5% say they found it helpful. Children go for Maths (57%) slightly more than English (49%). 30% of children think they go more than three times a week.
