Dear Parents,

This half term has flown by! I cannot believe that next week is the last week of term. The children in the two reception classes have nearly completed their first year of school, the children who are starting school in September have confirmed their places and our year six children are only 8 weeks away from leaving primary school!

The children in Year 6 were visited by members of staff from Stagecoach this week to give them important information that they will need when they are travelling to and from secondary school next September. It has been recommended that parents purchase a Young Person's Travel Pass (YPTP) for £270 which will work out almost a quarter of the annual price of a daily fare! These are available to buy on www.kent.gov.uk and the application deadline is July 15th. The passes will then be given to the children at school during the first week of term in September. If your child is going to Folkestone Acaedmy and you live more than 3 miles away you can apply for free transport on the same website. If your child in entitled to free school meals, it is worth investigating whether there is a discount for the YPTP. The children did bring home leaflets about this so, if you haven't received it, remind them about it!
