What you think we could do better:

- Seating outside with a shady area for people eating packed lunches
- Tables also need some attention
-Mr Wright is due to re stain and update benches before half term.
- Please think of ways of linking with and supporting the ASC
-We do work closely together and Miss Ward is the Chair Person of the ASC. We meet half termly.
- It would be nice for parents to be given a brief about how things change for children moving from Reception into Y1
-This year all parents in the Reception classes were given a leaflet explaining the changes that will take place on their move into year 1. I hope that helped.
- You could offer Mandarin / Chinese lessons
-This year we are changing the way we teach Modern Foreign Languages and are introducing a wider range of languages for children to learn. Miss Dawe will be writing an article in the school newsletter to tell you more before half term.
- I have concerns around the provision of toilet facilities and lack of hot water for children and adults
-The adult toilets (which were in a very grotty state) were refurbished over the summer holidays and have hot water running now! The toilets for the children are on a refurbishment schedule. Some have recently been refurbished. All have hot running water. In October half term the 'Blue boys toilets' are due for a referb and over Christmas the boys toilets in the link. The taps in the girls toilets in the link are due to be replaced before half term!
- Lack of landing pad assemblies this year
-Landing Pad Assemblies take place in terms 1 & 4. In term 2 Years 3,4,5 &6 have landing pad assemblies but years 1,2 and Reception are in charge of presenting the Nativity. Terms 2 and 5 are so short it is difficult to squeeze one in! In term 6 there are so many events that we do not have one. Landing Pad Assembly dates are on the reverse of the school newsletter
