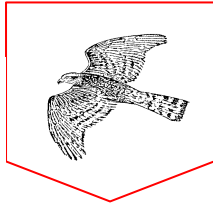

Dear Parents of pupils in Year 6,

I am excited to be able to tell you that we are planning on taking all our Y6 pupils to see War Horse at The Marlowe Theatre in Canterbury on Wednesday 27th September. The children in Year 6 are currently reading the book as part of their English lessons, so this will be a fantastic opportunity to see the stage production.

We are running this at no cost to children. All we ask is that you can return the slip below giving your child permission to attend.

We are booked in for an afternoon performance. The coach will be leaving school at 1pm (after the children have had lunch) and returning at approximately 6pm (depending on traffic - we will text you when the coach has left Canterbury!). The children will need to wear full school uniform, but not need any money or bags with them.
