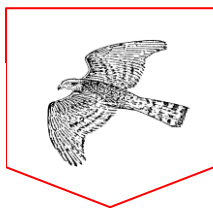


# Hawkinge Primary School

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

Current trends with technology use amongst children:

- Forty-six per cent of parents agree with the statement: 'my child knows more about the internet than I do'.
- Agreement increases with each age group: 22% of parents of those aged 5–7; 35% of parents of those aged 8–11; and 67% of parents of those aged 12–15.
- In addition, 54% of those aged 12–15 say that they know how to delete their online history and 26% say they have done this in the last year.
- Twenty-two per cent say they know how to disable any online filters or controls, while 8% say they have done this in the last year.
