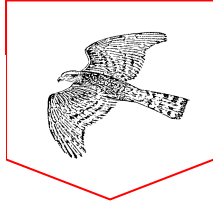

Dear Parents,

It has been great to see so many parents and children taking part in our 'Tommy Hunt' around the school this week. This will consist of a cheese baguette, homemade biscuit, packet of pom-bears, piece of fruit and a bottle of water.
- Please ensure children are in promptly on this day. All teaching staff will be at the pantomime with the children so there will be no teachers in school after the last coach has left. If your child is ill and not in school on this day would you please inform us in line with normal school procedure.
