Week	English	Parent comment
1	Read the story of the Lion and the Mouse to your child. Ask them questions about the story. Is there a message in it? Ask your child to sequence the events verbally to you and then draw pictures on the story board to tell what happened.	
2	Play the sentence wall game with your child. Ask your child to write down the sentences they make, reminding them to start with a capital letter and end it with a full stop.	
3	Cut up the letters of the alphabet. Ask your child to put them in order. Then to write the corresponding capital letter on the back of each letter.	
4	Pick out 10 letters for your child and ask them to put them in alphabetical order. Repeat the task with 15 letters.	
5	Mix the letters up and place face down on a table. Take it in turns to choose 5 letters - can you make a word? Extension: choose 7 letters. Can you make more than one word?	
6	Discuss when we need to use a capital letter with your child eg; names, places and to start a sentence. Say names and places are proper nouns so they need a capital letter. Complete worksheet on proper nouns.

5	<p><u>Dominoes</u> Cut out the dominoes and play the game of matching the number of spots together.</p>	
6	<p><u>Dominoes</u> Add up the totals on the dominoes and sort them into odd and even numbers.</p>
