Primary children at risk from video games

A survey has revealed that many primary school children are playing games meant for older children. Despite having an age rating of 13, 26% of primary school children played Clash of Clans. Some 9% of primary and 11% of secondary school children admitted communicating with strangers on Clash of Clans, according to findings by online safety group Internet Matters. Children spend an average three hours a day online playing games and are vulnerable to grooming, says Internet Matters, which has launched a TV ad campaign with Disney highlighting the dangers.
