

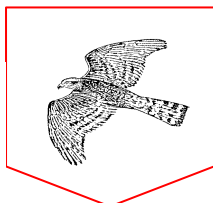

Dear Parents,

This time next week we will be gearing up for Easter celebrations - hopefully with good weather for all the Easter Egg Hunts that will take place in peoples back gardens! In the meantime we have got a lot to fit in during the next week at school.

This weekend is a busy weekend with Easter Crafts starting at 10am on Saturday morning - please come along with your son / daughter and create some Easter craft items. Each item that you paint on the table will cost £5, this pays for the pottery, painting fees and the firing of the pottery. It will be delivered back to you before we break up.
