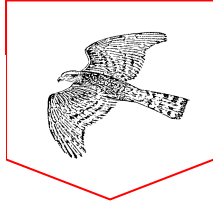

Term 3 pupil voice

Last term's pupil voice was about lunchtimes and break times. The children were asked by their leaders some questions from a questionnaire made by Miss Tappenden. Some of the questions involved: lunchtime supervisors, buddies and how they feel at lunchtimes. Then they rated lunchtimes and break times out of 10. 86% of children said they enjoyed break and lunchtimes, with 62% strongly agreeing

77% said they can usually find the help they need if they have a problem, with 54% strongly agreeing

The price of breakfast club places will be increasing after the Easter break to £2 per child per day. We are sadly having to increase our prices due to the rising cost of food in the supermarkets.
