Information for Y5 parents - Kent Test arrangements – 2014/2015

How to register: You can register when your child is in year 5 at primary school.

Register online between **2nd June and 1st July 2014** if your child is due to start secondary school in September 2015.

By post: Download a Kent Test registration form (available from 2nd June 2014), call 03000 41 21 21 or email kent.admissions@kent.gov.uk to request a form

Test date: Your child will take the test in year 6 at primary school. If your child already goes to school in Kent they will sit the test on **10th September 2014**. The test has:

- a reasoning paper (multiple choice)
- a literacy and numeracy paper (multiple choice)
- a written exercise.

The multiple choice test papers are marked by an automated marking machine. The written test will not be marked, but may be used by a local headteacher panel to review borderline cases.

If you register online you will be emailed the results after 4pm on 15th October 2014. You will also be sent the results by first-class post on 15th October 2014.
