Monday 7th July

Dear Parents,

We had a very exciting day here on Friday! As many of you will know there was a power cut in Hawkinge that started as the children came into school! We had a very busy hour trying to sort out arrangements so that we did not have to close the school. Kevin, Rachel and Hayley (who work in the kitchen) were absolute stars! Kevin drove to Whitstable to our meat supplier and brought a batch of burgers, whilst Rachel stayed at school and prepped the rest of the food. Mr Wright got the school and PTFA BBQs out and we were ready to use them to cook lunch for 125 pupils!! Luckily the electricity company were able to reconnect our power as we are a school as a priority, so we were relieved at just gone 11am that the power was re connected and the BBQs did not have to be used! The children ate on paper plates (which we found in the PTFA cupboard) because the water would not have been hot enough to sterilise the plates! The children thought it was great fun! I am sure they told you all about it!

A group of our pupils represented the school last week in the Walter Tull Football Tournament which is held annually at Mundella School in honour of Walter Tull (Walter Tull was born in Folkestone in April 1888 his father had arrived from Barbados in 1876. Walter Tull is famous because he was the first ever Black officer in the British Army, the first black officer to lead white men into battle and the first black outfield player to play professional football in Britain!) The team played exceptionally well winning their games: 3-1, 4-0, 4-0, 2-0. The semi-final match ended in a 0-0 draw, but Hawkinge Primary School won on penalties. They played St Martin's primary School which ended in a 1-1 draw, but once more they won the final on penalties! Photographs of the team (and the trophy) will be added to the school website this week. Mr O'Brien said that the team played exceptionally well! The team was made up of boys from years 5 & 6 - Tyler, Logan, Freddie, Charlie, Kain, Jack, Tegan & Josh! Well done!
