Sports Day Reminder - Tuesday 19th June

Sports Day for children in FS, years 1 and 2 will be from 10:00-11:30 a.m. on the school field.

For children in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 sports day will be from 1:15 - 3:00 p.m. on the school field.

Parents are more than welcome to bring a chair/blanket to sit on!

We would like once again this year, if possible, for children to wear a T-shirt with the colour of their house as part of their P.E. kit.

Children will complete a variety of sporting activities in house teams, before competing in a more competitive sprint race at the end.

Reminders:

- Children must not wear jewellery for Sports Day/P.E. activities as our P.E. policy clearly states.
- You are more than welcome to take photographs of your child - but not of any other children. Please do not publish photographs of children that do not belong to you (!) on social media sites. This could lead to some of our children being put in a dangerous situation.
